Barley Village Hall ~ March

Work has begun on the 'face lift' for the front of the Hall; the rather scraggy bushes have been removed and will be replaced with suitable low maintenance plants. The railings are being sand blasted and will be repaired and painted as soon as we have a few days of dry weather. Pointing and detail repairs to the stonework will complete the upgrading of the frontage.

On the 10th of February we ran a very successful Basic Food Hygiene Course organised by the Lancashire Association of Village and Community Halls and sponsored by Community Futures. A total of 21 delegates were trained and a further course will be run at Brindle Community Hall on the 17th March.

Local and Lancashire County Councillors held a meeting in the Hall and were impressed by the facilities we now offer.

Thanks to Mr David Goodger, we have been able to obtain three large-scale local maps, which will be displayed permanently. These should be of interest to both locals and visitors alike.
